

Live Aboard Application

Any person seeking to live aboard for a continuous and regular period must complete this application. Short-term visiting yachts (less than 6 months in any 12 month period) and long-term berth holders may stay overnight on their vessels. **It is only possible to live-aboard on a pile mooring for 6 months, however it may be possible to stay on a pontoon for a longer period dependant on total live-aboard numbers.**

Liveaboard numbers are set and regulated by Whangarei Marina Management and the Marina Trust. A wait list will be held for approved applications if the quota is considered full. **Approval to Live Aboard remains at the absolute discretion of WMM at all times.**

Sewerage Containment

A cable tie is used to seal sewerage seacocks in the closed position and must be sealed the entire time your vessel is berthed in the marina. The seal can be broken to service toilets, however it must be sealed at completion of the service. The Marina Office is well stocked with cable ties if required. As per The Trust Terms and Conditions for Berth Rental (clause 10.1): Marina Staff may request to board your vessel to check sewerage discharge seacocks are sealed.

Tick which option you will use to prevent sewage discharge.

- (a) The vessel is equipped with a **sewage holding tank**. The overboard seacock will be sealed to the closed position; **or**
- (b) The vessel is equipped with a **portable toilet** on board. A portable toilet is defined as a sewage containment device constructed of impermeable materials which is fully self-contained and removable, and consists of two independently sealed chambers comprising of water holding tank and a sewage holding tank separated by a slide valve. The overboard seacock must be sealed to the closed position; **or**
- (c) If your vessel is not equipped with, as above a or b then overboard sewerage seacocks must be sealed to the closed position and shore facility toilets must be used.

I acknowledge receipt of and understand that I must comply in all respects to the marina's Terms and Conditions, available on the website or in the Marina Office. Failure to comply with such rules, Policies or instructions may result in immediate termination of the agreement.

I also note and agree:

- That if on a **Pile Mooring** in the Town Basin I may only live onboard in the marina for 6 months in any 1 year and the vessel is to be on a visiting moorage rate.
- That if on a **Pontoon Berth** long-term (more than 6 months in any 12-month period) permission is upon application. Live-aboard is limited to a total number of boats permitted by WMM.
- The vessel's owners and family only are to live onboard. Proof of ownership may be asked for.
- If using **shore-power** the vessel shall have a current Warrant of Fitness and the cord is tested and tagged annually.
- There are to be no obstructions left on the marina piers.
- Long term live-aboards are encouraged to help monitor security, report maintenance requirements eg. broken lights and assist visiting arrivals.
- The vessel must be maintained **seaworthy** and in a tidy condition.
- **Absolutely no Sewerage Discharges into the Marina.**
